1st Apparition

In the Spring of 1916
Location: Loca do Cabeco

As the children were at a hilltop cave looking after the sheep, they saw a figure approaching above the olive trees.

The Angel: Do not fear! I am the Angel of Peace. Pray with me.



The Angel then knelt, bowing low with his head touching the ground.

The three children, impelled by a supernatural impulse, did the same, and then repeated after him:

The Angel: My God, I believe, I adore, I trust, and I love Thee. I beg pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not trust, and do not love Thee.

Having repeated this prayer three times, the Angel rose and said:

The Angel: Pray thus. The Hearts of Jesus and Mary are attentive to your supplications.

Then he disappeared.

2nd Apparition

In the Midsummer of 1916
Location: Well of Arneiro

The children were playing behind Lucia's family home near a well, when the Angel suddenly appeared.

The Angel: What are you doing? Pray! Pray a great deal! The Hearts of Jesus and Mary have merciful designs upon you. Offer prayers and sacrifices continually to the Most High.

Lucia: How are we to make sacrifices?

The Angel: Make everything you do a sacrifice, and offer it as an act of reparation for the sins by which He is offended, and as a petition for the

The Angel of Peace

At a time when Europe was at war, three shepherd children of Fatima — Lucia dos Santos and her two cousins, Francisco and Jacinta Marto — were visited three times by the Angel of Peace. He came as Precursor to instruct and prepare them to receive and understand the great message of the Queen of Heaven, which they were soon to live and transmit.

The Angel resembled a young man, whiter than snow, which the sun rendered transparent as if it were of crystal, and of great beauty.

3rd Apparition

In the early Autumn of 1916
Location: Loca do Cabeco

As the children were praying by the cave, the Angel appeared, holding in his hands a Chalice surmounted by a Host, from which drops of Blood were falling into the chalice.

Leaving the Host and Chalice suspended in mid-air, the Angel prostrated himself and repeated three times:

The Angel: O most holy Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, I adore Thee profoundly. I offer Thee the most precious Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in tabernacles throughout the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges, and indifference by which He is offended. By the infinite merits of the most Sacred Heart of Jesus, in union with the immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of Thee the conversion of poor sinners.

Rising, the Angel took the Host and Chalice, giving the Sacred Host to Lucia, and the Sacred Contents of the Chalice to Jacinta and Francisco, saying:

The Angel: Take and eat the Body and drink the Blood of Jesus Christ, horribly outraged by ungrateful men. Make reparation for their crimes and console your God.

He then prostrated himself again, repeated the prayer three times to the Most Holy Trinity, and disappeared.

A EVANFELIZAR.....: (Mc 16,15)

“.....Ellos salieron a predicar la conversión, echaban muchos demonios, ungián con aceite a muchos enfermos y los curaban”

El primer objetivo de esta iniciativa de Jesús con sus discípulos es compartir con ellos la vida, sus inquietudes, sus futuros planes y hacer conocer el Reino a todo el mundo, de ahí la necesidad de predicarlo anunciarlo.

Nos encontramos con el primer viaje apostólico o primer misión de la historia del cristianismo. Es como el prelude de la actividad misionera universal de la Iglesia. este proyecto quedará un día plasmado y será anunciado solemnemente después de la pascua: “Id por todo el mundo y proclamad la Buena Nueva a toda criatura” (Mc. 16,15).

La misión evangélica comprende la lucha contra todas las formas del mal. Exige cualquier esfuerzo para mejorar la situación espiritual y también social de nuestros pueblos. Evangelizar no es solo predicar un mensaje, sino posibilitar y promover la liberación del hombre de cualquier forma de injusticia o esclavitud.

Hoy más que nunca la misión universal de la Iglesia tiene delante un importante reto: el de la inculturación de la fe: “el reino que anuncia el Evangelio es vivido por los hombres profundamente vinculados a una cultura; y la construcción del reino no puede por menos de tomar los elementos de la cultura y de las culturas humanas” (Pablo VI).

Escasez de vocaciones: la frase evangélica, “la mies es mucha y los obreros pocos”, es siempre una llamada urgente a la conciencia misionera de la Iglesia. Más en este tiempo de alarmante escasez de vocaciones. Juan

Pablo II en uno de sus discursos decía: “Sed más dóciles a la voz del Espíritu. Dejad que resuenen en la intimidad de vuestro corazón las grandes expectativas de la Iglesia y de la humanidad. No tengáis miedo en abrir vuestro espíritu a la llamada de Cristo. Responded con entusiasmo a la invitación del seguimiento radical”. Esta es una invitación para que en la familia, nuestros jóvenes conozcan la propuesta del seminario, como opción de vida, pero ustedes papás están invitados a motivarlos.
